'Images from Bergamo': New revelations

a leading police trade unionist spoke, among other things, about the 'images from Bergamo'.

Politicians are still using the 'Bergamo images' for propaganda, thereby legitimising their coronavirus policy, which began with the 'Bergamo images' and then took a firm hold of Europe for years. The myth behind the military transport that removed bodies from Bergamo has long been deconstructed. Now a new detail has come to light.

Bergamo bluff

After funerals were cancelled and gravediggers were confined to their homes in lockdown, the city (without an ordinance) switched to cremation – the dead were burned. Because the local crematoria were unable to cope, the bodies were transported to neighbouring provinces – with the help of the military. This is the short story of the 'images of Bergamo'. This phrase was later used to argue in favour of lockdowns, because that would prevent 'the images'.

Now, in 2024, the situation is being addressed – at least partially. In Italy, Antonio Porto, the secretary of the police union, testified before the parliamentary commission of inquiry at the

end of November. He also spoke about the military convoy. His revelation? In each military truck, only a single coffin had been transported. <u>Uncensored</u>, which reported on the testimony, writes: 'And he asked the question "why" in his hearing: Who and what did they want to convey to the population with these images that did not correspond to their alleged message, that is, that they were lying?'

<u>Here is an excerpt from Porto's testimony</u> before the Covid Commission in Italian [with English subtitles]:

'With the 'coffins of Bergamo', we immediately knew 'something was wrong',' Porto said.

This is how the Italian press reported his appearance:

'We noticed the discrepancy between reality and what was being reported in the media from the very beginning,' Porto said, and went on to describe how impossible it was for the police officers to object: 'Unfortunately, many had to obey: you had to go through the hierarchical channels, and those were the orders. Some were even disciplined'.

The union also presented data that questions the effectiveness of the measures taken, particularly with regard to vaccinations, although these are not currently being investigated: 'In two months, we had almost 50 per cent of the total number of two-year-olds infected,' says Porto, referring to the period after the introduction of compulsory vaccination. The vaccinations, according to the secretary of the OSA police, were also achieved through symbolic propaganda: 'We couldn't understand why there was only one coffin per lorry in Bergamo, even though it could have held two or three. We immediately realised that something was wrong and what the goal was'.

Of course, there is also criticism of the statement. For example, the police could not possibly have known how many coffins would have been transported. Porto also touched on other controversial topics. For example, the protests at the port of Trieste against the Green Pass, the Covid certificate:

"Today, with even more force and supported by numerous court rulings, we can say that many of these regulations, which restricted the freedom of others, were unlawful! We apologise to all Italian citizens for what they suffered at the hands of the state and its institutions at that time.

The events in Trieste on 18 October 2021, when water cannons were used by state police against defenceless demonstrators sitting in silent protest, are emblematic of this. This fact represents the culmination of a dark page in the history of Italian democracy, because to this day no one knows, and no one seems to care, who gave the order to use force against such peaceful and symbolic dissent, which certainly deserves the removal of helmets and certainly not the indictment.
